On behalf of the NMPPS staff I want to reiterate the message that was shared by the TDSB in response to the demonstrations that happened earlier this week:

Every day, staff across TDSB support student achievement and well-being, and work hard to create inclusive spaces where every student feels valued, seen and empowered.

We want to make it unequivocally clear that TDSB stands with our trans, Two-Spirit and non-binary students, staff and families, and we support everyone's human rights and expression of gender.

Harassment, discrimination and hate have no place in TDSB. In our schools, we do not tell students who they should be, but welcome them as they are. We do this by focusing on their academic learning and fostering feelings of belonging as expected in the Ontario curriculum and the Ontario Human Rights Code.

Entry Routines

At Nelson Mandela learning starts from the classroom line up at the start of the day. Lining up and entering the building with the class helps build routines and sets a positive tone to the day. Calm transitions in the morning and through the day creates a safe and caring learning environment.

The students and staff will be focusing on safe entries, transitions and dismissals starting this Monday. Please support us by talking to your child about what it means to behave safely in school and by ensuring your child arrives on time. In school we often read Social Stories to our younger students to help them understand. Please see an example of a social story about Walking in Line and Not Being First. You can read this with your child.

Remember, if your child is late they will need to go to the office and get a late slip. Parents may not drop their children off directly in class.
