Dear parents/guardians,

We are writing to notify you of a change in location for the Junior Extended French program (grade 4 entry) currently located at *John English Junior Middle School*. Due to accommodation pressures at John English, this program will be relocated to *Second Street Junior Middle School* beginning with grade 4 entry classes for September 2016. Students currently enrolled in Extended French at John English will be able to remain in the program at John English until completion of grade 8; however, John English JMS will not be taking in new grade 4 classes beginning in September of 2016.

At the same time that the program is phasing out of John English, it will be phased into Second Street – one grade at the time – beginning in September of 2016. The secondary school pathway will not change as a result of this relocation. Currently, students graduating from John English’s Junior Extended French program (at the end of grade 8) who choose to continue their secondary studies in Extended French move on to Richview Collegiate Institute. This will also be the secondary Extended French pathway for students who graduate from the newly established Second Street Junior Extended French program.

Students living in the regular program catchment area for the following schools are currently associated to John English’s Junior Extended French program and, beginning in September 2016, will be associated with the Second Street program:
