- -all members make decisions for councils
- -require school council by-laws
- -minimum number of meetings is 4
- -people who sit on council: teaching staff, parents, non-teacher rep, community rep there needs to be more parents in a meeting for it to be official
- -every school gets a minimum of \$300
- -there are external grants that you can apply for and Parent Reaching Out Grants
- -required to buy additional school council insurance if holding major fun fair or rent/buy special equipment
- -need TDSB email account for access to grants and other central resources
- -who is our PIAC rep?
- -Business Services provides financial and supplies for school council parent workshops
- -school council is an advisory group and provides advice to the school principal or the School Board level on any matter

Responsibility of School Council

- -constitution of by-laws (how many parents will make up the school council/package goes home to inform parents about elections/host an election evening package to go home 14 days before elections)
- -recording
- -reporting
- -consultation
- -communicating
- -should be framing our work around the SIP
- -SAC should consult on the SIP
- -should be speaking from the needs of the families
- -survey to parents to see what skills they can volunteer if they don't want to be part of council or attend meetings
