Return this form to your child's school office within two weeks. Request for Immunization Information for New Students Instructions for Parents/Guardians

1. Please fill in the dates of each needle (year/month/day) or attach a clear photocopy of the student's immunization record. Both sides of the record must be included.
2. Be sure your Child's Name, Ontario Health Card Number, Date of Birth and School Name are clearly shown on the record.
3. If you do not have an immunization record for your child, take this form to your doctor to complete.
4. To inquire about exemption from immunization for medical, religious or conscience reasons, call the Immunization Information line at 416-392-1250. If there is an outbreak at school, children who are not adequately immunized will not be able to attend school unless the child receives the vaccine or the outbreak is over.
5. If you do not have an Ontario Health Card and can't afford a doctor's services for immunization, call 416-392-1250. You will receive information about how your child can obtain the necessary needles.
6. Provide all information and return the form to your child's school office within two weeks. If you wish to provide this information directly to Toronto Public Health, please call the Immunization Information line at 416-392-1250.
7. Keep your child's immunizations up to date and a copy for your record.

Each time your child receives a needle, you are required to inform Toronto Public Health You can do so by:
