## PTI Ambassadors

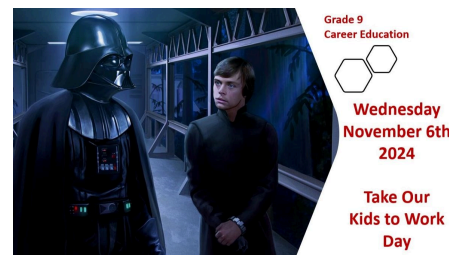
