Shared some highlights from the conference 12 ideas (see attachment) Co-chair thanked Kayla and suggested that she choose two ideas from the list for the school council to try. Kayla said she would review the list and would be happy to hear if there was an idea from the list that parents would be interested in trying.

10) Grade 12 Teacher Concerns

Ali Lila

Ali shared concerns that were brought to him from a parent(s)

- i) new teachers that are teaching grade 12 to have ability and manage subject matter. Example, History.
- ii) how they look at marks and then abruptly change an earlier grade which is a big change in the marking.
- iii) Parents have difficulty understanding teachers' accent (grade 12) which becomes challenging for parents to communicate with their teacher.
- iv) teaching styles- teaching math standing in front of board
- v) Teachers should adapt to students' learning style
- vi) young teachers teaching grade 12-what is their experience of the subject?
- vii) young teachers have newer teaching styles for grade 12 students that they are not used to
- viii) young teachers lack classroom management skills
- ix) What strategies are available for young teachers
- x) What are the qualifications when hiring young teachers, including inclusiveness

Discussion was brought about parent communication and the Parent Protocol which is shared in the weekly Newsletter (see newsletter for complete details) Summary of the steps Step 1 student talk with the teacher-there should be open communication between the student and the teacher before parent /teacher interview Step 2: Parents open communication with teacher (again before parent/teacher interview) timeline 24-48 hours Step 3 parents talk with Vice-Principal (subject knowledge) Step 4 Vice-Principal talk with teacher and department head

Discussion about what is currently to address this issue and solutions for new or relatively new grade 12 subject teachers.

- i) Additional support for subject material
- ii) Class management
- iii) Have teachers with other teachers to help other new teachers
- iv) Pair up teachers when possible
- v) Department heads are aware of teachers who need support
- vi) The Board DOES have coaching available. Younger teachers are released to go for coaching and then the class is taught during the time by a substitute
- vii) Acknowledged that newer teachers need mentors
- viii) Newer teachers do share newer experiences with the students and the subjects they are teaching
- ix) Students also need to advocate for themselves
- x) It takes time for teachers to learn how to teach the curriculum quickly to the students

Feedback from parents regarding that they have had open communication with the high school teachers sending emails to the teachers. That parents are advocating by reaching out to teachers prior to parent /teacher interviews
