<b>Registration Steps</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Login to Registration site (do NOT use Google Chrome)</li> <li>2. Choose course then submit. (For Remote - Civics &amp; Careers MUST be at the same school)</li> <li>3. You will receive an email immediately from <b>E-reg</b> with an attached Consent Form</li> <li>4. Forward the Consent Form to your guidance counsellor <u>AND to your parent email</u> at the same time. <u>If you are 18 years old</u>, forward the consent form to your counsellor and state that you are 18. <b><i>(Please include your replacement course in your email if your summer class is on your course requests for next year; Otherwise an Alternate course will be used.)</i></b></li> <li>5. Guidance counsellor approves you (if eligible) and you will receive an email saying that you are enrolled. <b>YOU ARE NOT IN THE COURSE UNTIL STEP 5 IS COMPLETED!!!!</b></li> <li>6. Follow up with your guidance counsellor if you did not receive the email in Step 5!</li> </ol>
