Good afternoon Oakridge Parents, Guardians & Families,

We would like to thank you for your patience while we work through the process of safe school reopening. We know a part of feeling a sense of comfort and security involves communication and understanding. We felt it necessary to wait until there were definite board and school plans to share. It is also important that we continue to prepare the school so students and staff are safe and in order for students ean to receive a high quality education. Below are some updates.

Results of the Pre-Registration Survey

The TDSB contacted you either by phone or by email to ask if you intend to send your child to school on a *Regular School Day Model* (full day of learning in school every day) or if your child will not be attending school and will participate in the *Virtual School for Remote Learning*.

Preregistration results from Oakridge families are below:

Class Sizes (In-School Regular Day)

Next week we will receive our school allocation which will indicate the number of classes, teachers, educators and support staff at Oakridge. Our school composition is based on the preregistration survey. Once we've completed the staffing process, parents will be informed as to the name of their child's teacher followed by information about opening day procedures. Please expect communication either next Thursday or Friday.

Virtual School (Remote Learning)

Parents who've chosen this option will receive communication from the Principal and/or teacher of the virtual school. Please note, the virtual school is staffed centrally which means your child may not be taught by an Oakridge teacher or staff member.

Health and Safety

Oakridge has received shipments of personal protective equipment (PPE). As a school, we're in the process of reconfiguring our school to adhere to public health guidelines in addition to revising some of our protocols which include, the use of directional floor markings, signs that promote proper hygienic practices and respiratory etiquette, reducing certain social interactions and limiting non-essential visitors.

Student and Staff Well-Being

Recognizing the impact the pandemic has had on all of us, student and staff wellbeing will be at the forefront. We are all responsible for contributing to an environment that's positive, warm, welcoming and equitable. Emphasis will be placed on self-care, care for others, responsive relationship building and inclusivity.

In-School Learning

Following health and safety guidelines and emphasizing student/staff wellbeing, students will engage in a variety of learning opportunities. Your child's educational development will be based on assessment practices and then programming will be provided based on learning needs and curriculum expectations. It's important to note that students will require time to adjust to inclass learning. Further communication will be provided to you by your child's teacher and educator.
