PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

N. Quimby provided an update as follows:

Ongoing Virtual Schooling:

- **LUNCH SCHEDULE:** **N. Quimby** will be looking at the timetables to determine whether the schedules for families in multiple classes and grades can be synchronized. If anything is changed, a notice to the community will be provided.
- **MULTIPLE ZOOM LINKS:** There was a discussion about there being one virtual platform per day that teachers move in and out of rather than having the students/parents need to do that. This will be considered.

Staffing Update:

- **Ms. Shona** is taking a leave for two weeks. Ms. Gall is the LTO and started Monday.
- **N. Quimby** has been visiting all the virtual classrooms and is pleased with quality of teaching. A lot of planning goes into the virtual teaching and we are all very impressed.

Device Distribution:

- To date, we have provided 10 Chrome Books, 1 Laptop and 4 iPads. As we don't have any more Chrome Books, the remaining iPads will be reserved for younger students and the laptops for older students.
