WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

N. Quimby welcomed everyone.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

J. Lacombe motioned to approve the minutes from the February 9, 2021 meeting. **S. Lama** seconded.

PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

N. Quimby provided an update as follows:

Staffing Update

- This time last year, projected enrollment for 2020/21 was 291. Currently, projected enrollment for 2021/22 is 263. The TDSB is down 6000 anticipated enrollments due to international students and others moving out of the GTA.
- Given the above, we may lose 1 class/teacher.
- **N. Quimby** advised that Oriole Park will be staffed at these projections and if the actual numbers change, staffing and classes will be adjusted during the first month of school. All staffing decisions will be made in the best interest of the students. If interested in joining the group of parents who will assist with the staffing model, lease send an email to A. - As of today, Oriole Park has 27 pre-registrations for JK. Last year we had 48-50.
- We are closed for optional attendance unless the children are currently attending Treetop.

• We are in the position to hire a .5 secretary position.

Facilities Update

- Our three water bottle stations have been installed. There is one on each floor.
- Starting July, all exterior and interior doors and all exterior windows on the lower level are being replaced.
- Shortly, an outdoor gate will be installed where the portables are. Also, lines on the pavement will be painted.
- Additional garbage cans for the outside area will be priced.

COVID-19 Update:

- Oriole Park's ventilation system is sufficient and is in good working order. In addition, windows are being cracked or opened to further encourage air flow.
- In addition, every occupied classroom is getting a HEPA filter to help support air circulation.
- Student screening continues. **Please ensure that it's completed daily.** Remember that students cannot attend if family members have symptoms. We will have an ice cream party if we have 5 days without screening reminders/calls home. So far, we've had 1 day.
- Supply teacher supports continue to be an issue. They are in demand and in shortage
- T-Shirts (donation) are being planned by Grade 5s. The t-shirts will be ordered in due course. They will also be available to parents but at a cost on School Cash Online.

Survey

- A survey was sent to staff, parents and students (6 to 12) regarding COVID-19 well-being
 - 76 parents provided a response
 - \circ In our learning centre (LC1), there was a response rate of 39
 - Before the December Break, 89% of parents felt the students were protected. 70% of parents felt their students were at the level they should be and would progress well to the next grade. Same with virtual.
 - 80% were satisfied with communication from the school (families in virtual were slightly less satisfied)

- Teachers have requested that Parent Council fund Scientists in the Classroom. A. Tebo, K. Bardyn and N. Quimby will meet to discuss funding.
- Oriole Park is now looking to ensure all iPads are being used and will be redistributed to Grades 1 to 3.
- Any additional technology needs will be canvassed with staff.
