"I am very pleased to announce that the \$350,000 in local developers' fees I was able to secure has been transferred to the TDSB to support the construction of an accessible playground at Oriole Park PS.

As Oriole Park students and parents know well, the current playground is too small and inadequate for children with special needs at the school and in the wider community. The new accessible playground equipment will allow children of all abilities to participate, and to be included, in recreational activities with each other. Kids of every ability will have the opportunity to be included in the life of their school and play with all their friends. Construction of the walking track, outdoor classrooms, long jump pit and much more is currently underway.
