Your Voice

On the first day of school, Mayor John Tory announced that the city wants to install 50 speed

enforcement cameras in school and community zones - the province needs to pass legislation to do this. The Mayor also added that the city currently has 136 school safety zones and has plans to complete 63 more this year. The province's amendments would allow municipalities to: a) adopt, at their discretion, Automated Speed Enforcement (ASE) systems in school zones and community safety zones on roads with a speed limit under 80km/h in order to address speeding; and, b) gain acceptance into Ontario's Red Light Camera (RLC) program, through a streamlined process.
