

Out-of-Area Admissions

Online applications for both elementary and secondary Out-of-Area Admissions opens on January 6, 2025. This is the process whereby students can apply to attend a school outside of the school designated to serve their home address. Acceptance is subject to space availability and transportation is the responsibility of the applicant. The Elementary application deadline is January 31 at 4 p.m. and the Secondary application deadline is January 24 at 4 p.m.

To attend Junior Kindergarten in September 2025, children must turn four-years-old by December 31. To attend Senior Kindergarten in September 2025, children must be five-years-old by December 31.
