KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Kindergarten registration for families living in our district begins on February 1st! If your child was born in 2019 and you live in our district, please register on-line www.tdsb.on.ca/kindergarten

In addition, OOOPS is now open to students who live out of area if there is sibling currently attending our school. If this is the case, parents will need to apply to attend OOOPS through the **Out of Area Admissions Process**. The Registration Form for Out of Area Admissions (formally Optional Attendance Form) is **now an on-line form,** and the process will be managed centrally. <u>Out-of-Area</u> <u>Admissions Policy (P013)</u>.

The Elementary application will <u>close on Friday</u>, <u>February 10, 2023, at 4:00 p.m.</u> Please make sure you submit Out-of-Area Forms before the deadline. It is advisable that Elementary Forms be submitted by January 30th.

Grade 6 students often apply to attend schools under Optional Attendance for Grade 7. Please make sure you do this before the deadline.

In addition to writing, Kathy teaches at the University of Toronto, and speaks to children in schools and libraries around the world about the importance of understanding the Holocaust and keeping its memory alive.
