KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR IN-DISTRICT FAMILIES FOR SEPTEMBER Kindergarten registration for families living in our district will take place the week of February 5<sup>th</sup>. If your child was born in 2014 and you live in our district, please phone the school to make an appointment to register between February 5-9. You will need to bring the following documents:

- 2 proofs of address (driver's license, phone/cable/utility bill, tax form, rental lease, bank statement)
- child's birth certificate or passport
- child's immunization record
- child's health card

Online registration <u>for in-district families</u> will be available beginning February  $1^{st}$  – more information to follow.

#### <u>KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR OUT-</u> OF-DISTRICT FAMILES FOR SEPTEMBER

After we have registered in-district families and if space permits, we will be registering out-of-district families through Optional Attendance. Optional Attendance forms are due on February 16<sup>th</sup>. Please note that space is extremely limited and if the number of students on our waiting list (through Optional Attendance) exceeds the number of spaces available, we will be holding a lottery. Out-of-district registration will take place by appointment on March 26, 27, 28 and 29. You will need to bring the following documents:
