Walk to School Wednesdays

Why walk to school?

It's good for the environment, it's healthy to be active, and it's a great way to spend time with family and friends.

How does it work?

Every Wednesday, park the car and walk to school. Once your child arrives at school, he / she should find a Student Volunteer with a clipboard and have a tally mark added to the class total.

If your child gets a ride to school, park the car at least two blocks away and walk to school from there.

If your child takes the bus, he / she can walk a supervised lap around the school at morning recess to get credit for walking to school.
