Students at Lunch

If your child normally stays at school for lunch and will be leaving school property for any reason, the student must be signed out in the office by a parent / guardian or the office must be provided with a note from his / her parents / guardian. The note must include the date, full name of the student, and where he / she is going.

Students will not be allowed to leave school property without written permission.

Nice Weather Reminders / Appropriate Dress

Now that the nice weather is here, please take a few minutes to review appropriate dress expectations with your child:

- No spaghetti straps
- All undergarments (including bra straps) must be covered
- Shorts and skirts must be at least mid-thigh in length
- No muscle shirts or mesh shirts
- No bare midriffs or belly buttons showing
- No bathing suits

Parents will be contacted if students do not meet these expectations; the students may be sent home to get changed. If in doubt, err on the conservative side.

It is also recommended that students wear a hat, sunscreen, and sunglasses and bring a water bottle on hot, sunny days.
