The IB Diploma Programme



- A challenging 2-year curriculum (gr.11 and gr.12) based on international standards
- Well-rounded interdisciplinary education that opens doors for specialization in all post-secondary education pathways
- Students will develop skills and content knowledge required to be competitive in the global economy
- Highly-regarded and recognized around Canada and the world
- Creates independent learners and thinkers

The Benefits of IB



- Academic Strength of Curriculum
- Approaches to Learning: Research, Social, Communication, Self-Regulation, Thinking Skills
- Eagerness to learn, to accept and overcome challenges
- International frame of mind
- Extensive extracurricular involvement
- Better preparation and performance in university and the working world

OSSD Credits Earned



- IB students will earn approximately 33 OSSD credits
- 10-11 credits will be at the 4M/4U level
- For Ontario Universities: Average of 6 best 4M/4U credits (taking English and prerequisites into account) will be used for admissions

Parkdale's IB Graduates



- 100% accepted into university (90% into their first choice university)
- Parkdale's results are above the IB World schools average
- 95% were Ontario Scholars (>80% average)



The PreBac Programme at Parkdale



- Students begin in the PreBac Programme in Grade 9
- PreBac Programme: Grades 9-10
 - Follows Ontario requirements, assessments, and evaluation
 - Prepares students for IB
 - More material, faster
 - Introduces IB terminology, tasks
- IB Programme: Grades 11-12
 - IB courses span 2 years
 - Follows IB requirements, assessments, and evaluation
 - Prepares students for university

Forms study groups

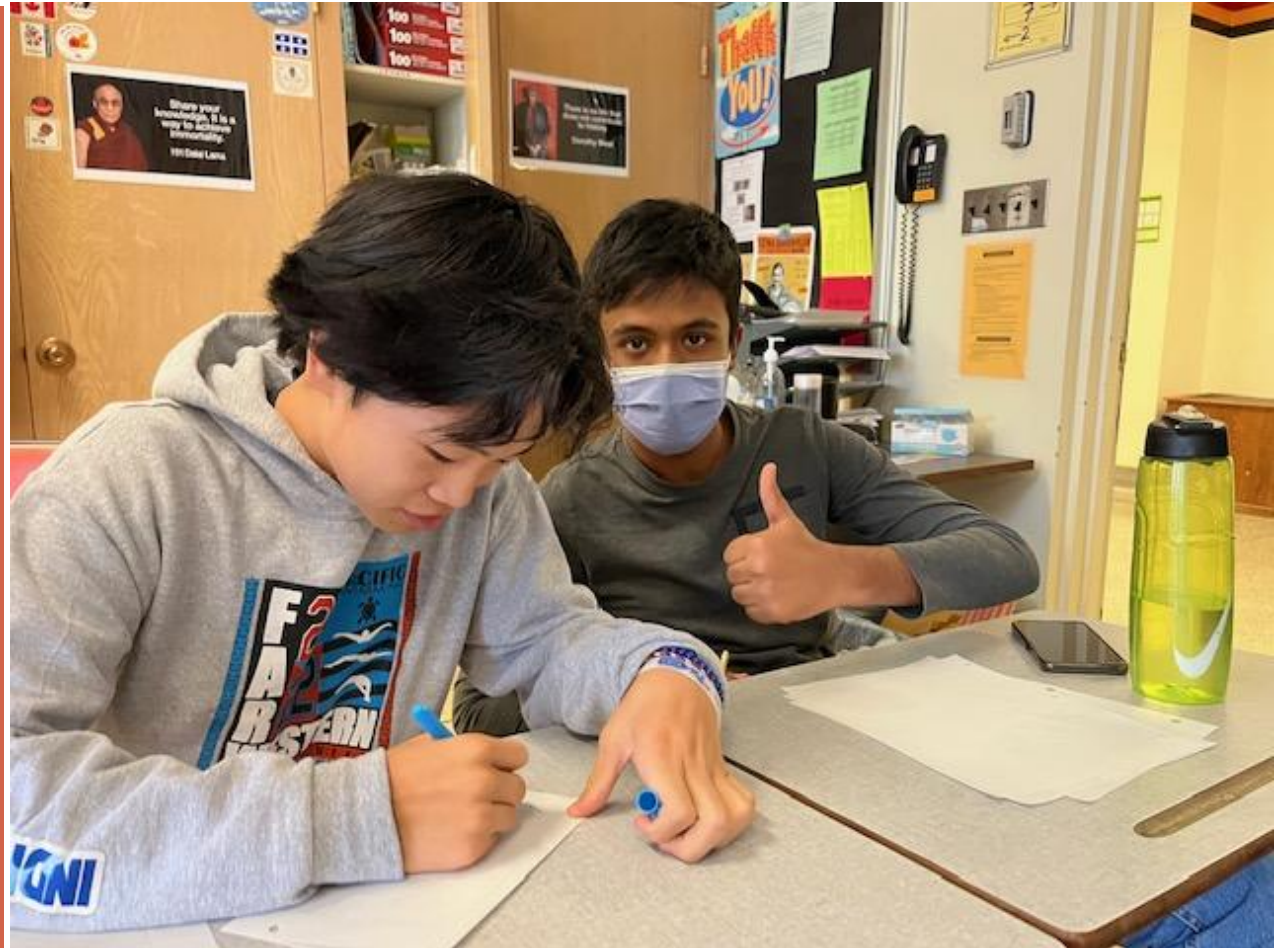
Participates in 1 club per year

Comparison with Gifted



IB	Gifted

Standardized international curriculum and assessment regime	Modified curriculum, not standardized, can vary from teacher to teacher
Transfer credits, IB Diploma and transcript	No transfer credits
Well-rounded, some flexibility	Specialize in certain areas

Comparison with AP



IB	AP
Follows an international curriculum and assessment regime and prepares for standardized exams	Prepares for standardized exams
Transfer credits with HL courses, IB Diploma and transcript	Transfer credits
Well-rounded, some flexibility	Specialization in certain areas

Comparison with TOPS



IB	TOPS
Follow a standardized international curriculum and assessment regime	Enriched curriculum in some subjects, some flexibility
Transfer credits with HL Courses, IB Diploma and transcript	Transfer credits with AP courses
Well-rounded, some flexibility	Specialization in Math and Science

Parent/Guardian Support of PreBac Programme



- Encourage your child to use their school agenda app as a time management tool between academic and extra-curricular activities
- Ensure your child has a quiet space to use daily for academic assignments and review
- Reinforce the necessity to complete homework tasks as per deadlines while maintaining academic honesty
- Encourage your child to seek extra help from classroom teachers as needed
- Encourage your child to become involved in clubs/teams at PCI
- Review the IB Learner Profile with you child and discuss how they demonstrate these qualities
