Registering with Homework Help 2012/13

To register your students, follow the directions below for either “School Enrolment” or “Home Enrolment.” In order for students to register, they need their OEN number. This number can be found on a student’s report card or on their timetable.

For Teachers - Enrolling Students at School

Before Class

1. Print off a list from Trillium with the students’ OEN numbers.
2. Book a computer lab for your class.

During Class

1. Have your students go to: **homeworkhelp.ilc.org**
2. Click on “**Register Now**” in the right corner.
3. Have students create a **username** (Do **NOT** use your own name) and **password**.
4. Have students select “**Student**” in the “**Type of User**” dropdown box.
5. Have students enter their **birth date** and **OEN number** (that you provided).
6. Have students enter a valid **email** address. (Note: this is optional, but recommended – if they forget their passwords, the email address allows them to retrieve them)
7. Have students read the “**Terms of Use**” agreement and select “**I have read.**”



If the student registered last year, the username will **automatically go back to their old username**. After they register, the **Welcome** message will remind them of their username – they will need to use this with the new password when they log in.

For students – Enrolling at home

Students will need their OEN number in order to register at home.

Guest Accounts

Parents and teachers may obtain guest accounts. Simply select “*guest*” as the account type when registering and then select either “*Educator*” or “*Guardian*”. Guest accounts allow parents and educators to explore the resources on the site and watch the interactions between students and tutors.
