Principal's Report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EQAO has been completed for all grade 3's and 6's. • Park Lawn is hiring a grade 1/2 teacher and a part-time grade 8 math teacher, who will also have a support role with other grades. • An increase in inappropriate student behaviour, such as name calling and physical aggression, has been seen of late. The school is acting proactively in the following ways: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All students in grades 4 - 7 will complete an anonymous school safety survey next week. The survey will ask questions about feelings of safety and experiences at the school and the results will be shared at September's SAC meeting. An action plan will also be developed based on the survey results. The same survey will be conducted next May to gauge improvements. 2. This month, the school's police officer will come to speak with the grade 7's about aggressive behaviour. 3. A letter will be going home to all parents with children in grade 6 & 7. 4. The school is encouraging kids to stand up for each other and discuss incidents with either teachers or parents. 5.
