By now all of you are aware of the Ministerial Order by the Ontario Minister of Education to close all schools from March 14th until April 5th. You should have received a letter on behalf of the TDSB by email this afternoon with further details. We recognize that this was not an easy decision on the part of the province but the measure is to mitigate and contain the spread of the COVID-19. Our YMCA Childcare Centre will also be closed and all school permits (Chinese and Tamil School) will be cancelled from March 14 through to April 5, 2020. Please note that the Ministry of Education has indicated that it will be providing resources that will be available online to support student learning at home during the closure.
