Prevention

Students

- Treat all with respect
- Follow classroom rules and school rules
- Be a positive role model
- Help friends solve problems
- Learn to be a helpful bystander

Parents

- Share concerns and suggestions with teachers
- Talk & listen to your children about bullying
- Appreciate and respect diversity in our school community
- Follow the boards code of conduct for parents

School

- Teach bullying prevention
- Develop classroom rules with students
- Invite police officers to discuss bullying at school and on internet
- Teach students to take responsibility for their actions as bystanders
- Staff trained and using restorative practice in classroom

Intervention

Students

- Immediately seek help when bullying is witnessed or experienced
- Get support from teachers
- As a bystander take action

Parents

- Immediately seek help when bullying is witnessed or experienced by own child
- Work collaboratively with school to resolve problems
- Learn about bullying by attending parent workshops

School

- Report all incidents of bullying immediately
- Implement progressive discipline
- Offer support to victims and their families

Bullying - is typically a form of repeated, persistent and aggressive behaviour that is directed at an individual or individuals that is intended to cause fear and distress and/or harm to another person's body, feelings, self-esteem, or reputation. Bullying occurs in a context where there is a real or perceived power imbalance. Bullying behaviour can also take place over the computer through the Internet or on social media websites.
