OTIP Teaching Awards 2020: Nominations are open

The Ontario Teachers Insurance Plan (OTIP) and the Ontario Teachers' Federation (OTF) are proud sponsors of the OTIP Teaching Awards.

For many years, these awards have recognized the excellence of our teachers in publicly funded education. There are three categories of awards: elementary school teacher, secondary school teacher and beginning teacher in the first five years of teaching. NO NUT PRODUCTS AT SCHOOL PLEASE!

Parents, our teachers are continuously confiscating products that contain nuts from our students. Under NO circumstances are NUTS or Peanut products to enter our school. Many of the chocolate treats that students are given contain nuts. We have our snacks inside our classrooms before or after recess, so we do monitor what students eat, and ensure that sharing of food does not happen. However, children who bring products that are not permitted in school are putting students and staff with severe nut allergies at risk. There are many school safe products that are available to your children for snacks.
