### **Inclusive Schools that are free of Bias and Hate**

The Toronto District School Board is focused on making all schools free of hate, bias and discrimination. It is important that parents are our partners in this work. We ask that families engage in conversations with their children about the impact of language used when engaging with others in person or on social media.

This year, TDSB requires that all incidents of racism, hate and bias are reported to our human rights office. Any language used in school (or off of school property involving students and brought to the school's attention, such as screen shots from social media or texts) is subject to reporting and will result in automatic suspensions or expulsions of students. We ask that each parent spend time reviewing the chart of consequences in the agenda (page 4) with their child(ren)

Our staff have been working with the students to understand the intent versus the impact of words. Slurs or remarks that mock someone's identity based on their race, religion, ethnicity, abilities, gender, age, sexual orientation, economic status, size, sexual identity or orientation is not permissible or acceptable at any time, regardless of what was meant (e.g., kidding). Mocking an aspect of someone's identity is an act of discrimination.

Our work is ongoing and we continue to learn better ways of addressing issues of discrimination and will continue to keep this dialogue open.

### **Hepa Filtration Units**

We received our HEPA Filtration units for each classroom. Although air purifying/cleaning technologies are part of Port Royal's central heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system, our school Board is providing portable units, which are intended for use in localized areas within a building, such as a single room. This will further assist with purifying the aerosols within a space.
