Message from the Principal:

We have completed our first week of school together. Although our routines are different from the

past, we have embraced our "new normal."

Our goal is to keep our school environment safe, welcoming and enjoyable for our staff and students. Our current focus is to support students with their mental health and well being, as we recognize the toll and impact COVID19 has made in their lives and their world.

Students have adjusted quickly to new school routines, and teachers are currently completing various diagnostic assessments to prepare students for learning.

As current health protocols prevent our teachers from writing directly in student agendas, students are still able to record their homework--and other relevant information, inside their agenda. We still encourage parents to check and sign the agenda as per previous practice.

All students have been provided with their TDSB Student Health Pass. They are required to have it signed and dated by a parent each morning prior to coming into the school. This is considered their first screening. When students arrive at school, the role of the staff is to verify that the students have been screened at home.

We have modified how we will be reviewing the health pass. We will be verbally verifying that the health pass is completed in the line up. If a child has not completed the pass, a staff member will go through the screening process with the child. Upon all students entering the school, the teacher will confirm all health passes are signed.

Please do not send your child to school if they answer YES to any of the screening questions.
