The recent worldwide growth of the ukulele is a musical phenomenon and we're very glad to be part of it.

In the past five years, Ukulele Kids has been responsible for teaching over 9,000 students in more than 160 Canadian schools to play and sing with the ukulele. It is so popular that first time registrations often reach in excess of 50 students. When we first introduced Ukulele Kids at Presteign Heights in 2011, we had 42 enrolled despite it being a small school!

Ukulele Kids programs provide an introduction to string instrumental music, combined with singing, to students who are too young for the formal instrumental music curriculum. For older elementary grades, we provide an added musical experience in a less formal learning atmosphere and an opportunity for personal vocal and instrumental expression.

Ukuleles and children go together like fish and water. The instrument is small and light, the fingerboard easily accommodates small fingers and the strings are kind to those fingers. Basic chords are easy enough to enable a child to be playing a song after the first lesson! Like most instruments, there is no limit to the possible complexity, but unlike most instruments, the threshold for enjoyment is easily reached.

We look forward to introducing your child to the magic of the ukulele or to continuing their fun learning experience!
