Thank you to council for the tables last year - they have all been placed in the classrooms this year and teachers are able to offer small group instruction, so helpful!

Progress reports will be coming out November 13th with Parent interviews on 14th and 15th - these reports will give a general overview of how students are progressing and what we need to do to support students

Book buying is coming up - Ms. Sheikh and Ms. Scott will be going to buy new library items - was a huge success last year to we are very excited to see what we get this year Student led initiatives - dance club, office helpers, door monitors and announcements - schedule is out until the end of December - these are including the younger students too!

There was some technical difficulties with the heating at PMJS - it is now working and everyone is toasty warm

Donations of Hallowe'en treats have been tremendous - thank you to everyone who brought them in - students are going to be getting lots of goodies!!

Budget - PMJS budget for 2024/2025 is \$60,402.00 - line items shared with council - can see that there are many mandatory expenditures - in consultation with teachers, Ms. Harroun has increased the money in sections that it was felt were not fully addressed in previous years On a funny note - the final line item of the budget is paper towels - there have been many discussions about how much to buy, who should pay etc. This line item will allow the washrooms and classrooms to be fully stocked with the brown paper towel!!
