- EQAO results Gr 9 math applied went down a little from last time. Moving toward academic pathways, moving away from applied. 87% in math and 90% in science.
- Over 1100 students this year largest ever with 55 teachers. 2 more teachers have been allocated
- TTC tickets no longer being provided to FI and Ext. French students
- Lost 4 teachers with shift of teachers. Still several teachers within the Board who have not been placed.
