Principal's Report - Lucie Kletke

- Thank you to all. We all must continue to work together as a team to address our students' needs, more now, than ever.
- It's wonderful to see students at school every day.
- 450 students are at school every day.
- We believe that one-on-one connection, between students and teachers, is critical to the well being of students
- Quad 1 ends on November 17th
- The mornings are long, but the students are engaged. The teachers are working so diligently in this new system.

Principal's Report - Lucie Kletke continued....

- No Final exams or culminating activities that would be worth 30% of the mark.
- 2 days will be "credit rescue" for students to ensure all assignments are handed in.
- Some classes have been split because of equipment. This includes 2 photography classes and the gr 11 marketing class. More teachers to accommodate this. The teachers work together as a "team".
- Quad 2 information from the Board is that they cannot accommodate any more on-line students.
- 75 students from Richview wish to move to on-line learning
- Currently staff is trying to figure out the #s to finalize the model for Quad 2. It will be difficult and challenging. There needs to be 110 hours per course.
- Budget for this year is lower than usual because of student #s. Budget for 2020-21 is \$230,000, compared to 2019-20 (\$265,000)
- Spent a substantial amount on technology for students and staff, already. Will need to replenish laptops/chromebooks that the Board took to provide devices for students during COVID.
- Individual Education Plans will be updated this week for our students
- Commencement for 2020 Graduates rescheduled to February, to coincide with reading week. The Board will not allow a function where individuals can congregate, or allow people in the school building. Thank you to Heather Smith for her proposal, but the Board won't approve it at this time. The Graduates were sent an update.
- Fitness Room closed down due to COVID restrictions
- Approx 100 Senior student volunteers want to connect with grade 9 students via ZOOM sessions....to make them feel welcome.
- Many groups and clubs are starting virtually:
 - Ms Calabria Principal's Advisory Group
 - Ms Pereira SAC & Richview Voice (newspaper)
 - Mr. Koumoutseas virtual Richview Athletic Club
