These and other past members worked concertedly to keep Riverdale's swimming pool open through grueling board budget challenges. School Councils receive funding from the Ministry of Education in 2 pockets: one based on student enrollment and the other a flat amount through Parent Engagement grants (separate from the Parents Reaching Out grants, which need to be applied for). Riverdale School Council gets \$500 per year towards the running of the council and another \$500 per year for parent engagement purposes. This money is delivered to council via the TDSB, through the school's budget. In 2010/11, Riverdale School Council used some of this money to subscribe to iContact, an email service, to increase parent communication.

We also launched a direct appeal to our families in the Fall with a fundraising request letter campaign. \$1700 was raised through this initiative, which goes to the school's Discretionary Fund. This money supports our students to enhance their opportunities at Riverdale.
