## 3. Matters Arising

## 4. Principal's Report

- a. Fall Fundraising Raised just under \$4,500 this year. Went over budget due to spending on guest speakers. Council confirmed their continued support of the fundraiser.
- b. Activity Fee will remain at \$50 for 2014/2015. Cost of the agenda planner is dropping to \$4. Difference will be used towards wellness initiatives.

- c. Mental Health plan, staff PD As per the plan, board-wide staff Professional Development is to start by June 2014. Staff have an online module to complete.
- d. School Budget forecast. Our budget looks stable for next year.
- 5. Ward 15 Update Donna Quon was present to discuss the Years of Action plan, as well as the proposed policy change for volunteers and their police reference checks.
