TDSB Summer school credit courses begin Tuesday, July 5 and end Friday, July 29, 2016. Final exams/Culminating Activities are Wednesday, July 27.

No alternative dates will be arranged. Family vacation plans cannot be accommodated.

Students may choose remedial credits, reach ahead credits, and E-Learning.

Remedial Courses

Student who have failed a core course with a mark above 35% can attend summer school.

Students attend for half a day, morning or afternoon.

Morning classes 9:00am - 11:45am, Lunch 11:45am - 12:30pm, Afternoon classes 12:30pm - 3:15pm

Registration is done in June after final marks through the school.

Full Credit Courses

Students that have the prerequisite can sign up for a full credit course. Many students use this as an opportunity to reach ahead and obtain a credit they are scheduled to take the next year. Many classes are held at Riverdale, some at other schools.
