



## ELEMENTARY PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITY (PA) DAY

February 13, 2026

During the school year, TDSB school staff participate in several Professional Activity (PA) Days. These days, while students remain at home, are an opportunity for staff to engage in professional learning or communication with parents through parent-teacher conferences, which directly impacts and enhances student learning.

As per the Ministry of Education’s Memo: [Mandatory Professional Activity Days for the 2025-26 School Year](#), school boards are required to designate three Ministry-mandatory PA Days. Additionally, school boards may designate up to four additional PA Days per school year with additional topics identified by both the Ministry and the TDSB. Professional learning activities for PA Days will consider factors such as achievement of learning outcomes in core academic skills, student engagement, and well-being. On February 13, 2026, staff will focus on reporting to parents and parent-teacher conferences.

Parent-teacher conferences are held to facilitate communication and collaboration between parents or guardians and teachers. The primary purpose of these conferences is to discuss a student’s academic progress, social development, and overall well-being. They provide an opportunity for parents and teachers to exchange information, celebrate successes, share concerns, and work together in the best interests of the student.
