If your child is going to be away or late to school for any reason, please call the school's Safe Arrival Line at 416-396-2437(not the main school number) and leave a message with your child's name, class, and reason.

Entry for Grades 1 to 6 classes is at 8:40 a.m. If your child is late, they must sign in at the office.

Similarly, if you are picking your child up during the school day, please visit the office and

not the classroom. It would be most helpful to write a note the day of informing your child's

teacher of such. If you need to drop off any item for your child, again, please visit the office,

and we will ensure that your child receives the item.

All visitors (including volunteers), please sign in at the office and collect a visitor's

badge. With over 300 Rolph families and so many new faces, it is impossible for us to differ-

entiate between a visitor and a stranger, without the badge.

Please remember that many of our students have life-threatening allergies, so it is essential that

you adhere to the food restrictions that may be set up by your child's teacher (based on the

allergies of students in the classroom). As a school, we ask that no nut or nut products come

to school at any time. Please inform the office immediately, if you have not already

done so, about any serious medical conditions that we should be aware of.

Thank you in advance for your support in ensuring the safety of all Rolph students. We are looking

forward to an amazing year, working as partners with parents and the Rolph Road community to

provide the very best learning opportunities for our students.
