Safety Reminders – Please review with your child(ren)

We remind all parents/guardians/caregivers to always hold your child's hand anytime you are in the school parking lot. Please do not let your children walk or run across the parking lot unescorted. <u>The path next to the iron fence is the best route to walk along</u>. Our Rolph Road team is counting on parents/guardians/caregivers to reinforce this message to children.

- In the event of an emergency, call 9-1-1 to report possible criminal activity.
- Contact the Toronto Police non-emergency number 416-808-2222 to report concerns about activities on school property after hours or on the weekend.
- Contact the TDSB Emergency Call Centre at 416-395-4620 to report concerns about activities on school property after hours or on the weekend.
- Encourage visitors to always discard litter in the appropriate recycling or garbage bins.
- Please also remember that there are no pets permitted in the schoolyard and especially on the field used daily for various sports tryouts, team practises and gym classes. Unfortunately, we have had instances when children have stepped or slipped on dog waste and soiled their clothing.

Italian Heritage Month at the TDSB

Italian Heritage Month is proudly recognized during the month of June at the TDSB since May 2012. The Province of Ontario also marks Italian Heritage Month since 2010 because the Italian Heritage Month Act (https://www.ontario.ca/laws/statute/10i17) was passed.

This year marks the 90th anniversary of the Christie Pits riot that took place in Toronto in August 1933. To commemorate this moment in history, the TDSB's Jewish Heritage Committee in collaboration with the Italian Heritage Committee are offering TDSB students a chance to learn about the largest race riot in Canadian history. This program is part of the committee's commitment to plan annual educational opportunities and to enrich the curriculum for further learning. With these actions our staff, students and our TDSB communities celebrate and learn about the diverse cultures of individuals within our schools and communities.

In addition to commemorating the 90th anniversary of the Christie Pits riot, the Italian Heritage Month planning committee has planned several virtual opportunities to celebrate the Italian heritage. All students, staff and the TDSB community are invited to a cooking lesson with Chef Gianni Ceschia. Chef Gianni Ceschia will lead us in cooking Risotto and Stuffed Gnocchi with a sauce.
