#### Improvements in the Kindergarten Yard

Some improvements are in progress in our busy Kindergarten Yard and students love watching the bobcat as they keep track of the changes! Students will have a new path (limestone screening material) to explore that runs north through the yard and a new circle has been created around the stumps/seating area just beside the front steps. One of the boulders in the yard will be moved to the round seating area. Grass will be grown in two areas that have the best growth under the tree canopy and we are also expecting a delivery of cedar shredded bark mulch throughout the yard.
