

Thank you to all families who are walking to school or arriving earlier which helps to alleviate the congestion and traffic concerns in front of the school.

As an update for all families, we currently have four different bus routes scheduled in our bus loading zone every morning and afternoon. Each morning, three different school buses pick up children in the catchment to transport them to special programs at other schools. We also have one school bus dropping off students who attend at Rolph Road.

The Early Literacy Family and Caregiver website is now available. It provides information for families about the vision of early reading in the TDSB and how to continue to explore early literacy at home.


