## Progress Reports will be sent Electronically on November 15<sup>th</sup>

All Progress Reports will be sent home electronically on Tuesday November 15<sup>th</sup>. Families will receive an email from School Messenger at the end of the school day with a link to the report card. The Progress Report is intended to provide you with an early indication of how your child is progressing at this point in the school year.

A large focus for the Progress Report for Grades 1-8 is the Learning Skills: Responsibility, Organization, Collaboration, Initiative, Independent Work and Self-Regulation. The development of these learning skills is an integral part of a student's learning. The Kindergarten Communication of Learning Report provides initial observations and information about your child's strengths and growth. Suggestions for the next steps your child is ready to take in their learning are also included.

Some teachers have already been reaching out to families to schedule parent-teacher conferences. The virtual meetings, in-person meetings, or phone calls will be scheduled during the week of November 14-18. This meeting is an opportunity to hear more about the day-to-day rich learning experiences in our classrooms, and the goals students are working to achieve. *Mr. Williams and Mr. Edmonds are away at Sheldon next week and will schedule conferences the following week.*

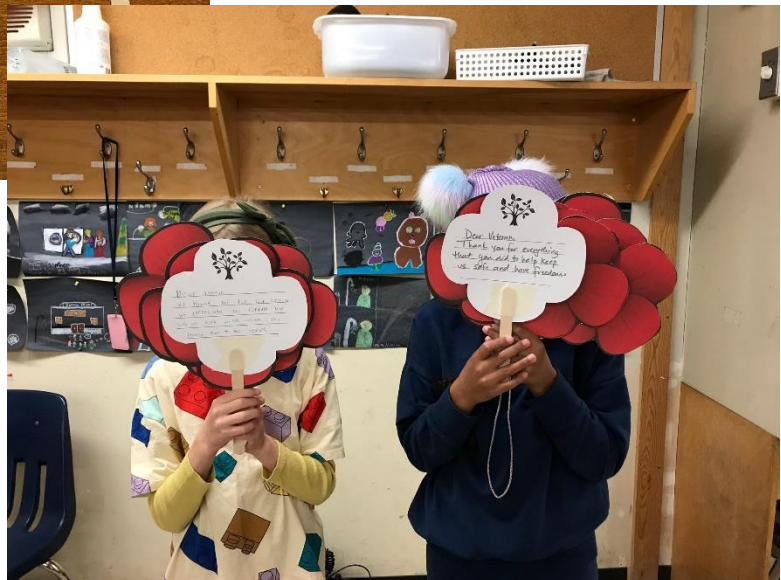
