Term One Provincial Report Cards & Term 2 IEPs

Individual Education Plans (IEPs) will be sent home electronically on Tuesday February 11th. 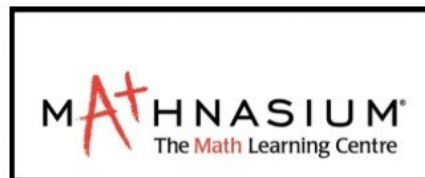
