We also encourage families to have their child(ren) rehearse getting dressed in all layers and all winter gear at home to support developing independence for entry/exit transitions at school. Teachers and support staff always promote and support development of important self-help skills and we want families to be aware of the challenges of getting large groups of children ready when there may be one adult supporting.

Always schedule your pick-up time <u>before or after recess</u> as we do not have extra staff to send outside to look for your child during the recess period. Ms. Themeliopoulos will be in the main office when Ms. Furxhi is on lunch.

Kindergarten Registration for September 2025

Kindergarten Registration at the TDSB is underway and we thank you if you have already started the registration process. Please encourage friends and neighbours to also register as soon as possible.

Families may register their child online using the Online Registration System (OLR) at www.tdsb.on.ca/kindergarten to begin the registration process.

Ms. Furxhi will review online submissions and will contact families in the coming weeks to schedule an in-person appointment to review documents and complete the registration process. Walk-in appointments are not possible currently as we do not have a school secretary.

All families who register their child for September 2025 will also be invited to attend an in-person Kindergarten Orientation session in late May or early June. *The date has yet to be finalized.*
