

### **Kindness Campaign & Recent Learning with Peter Lebuis**


Families will soon be seeing some posts and hearing about our **Kindness Campaign** at Rolph Road, as part of our ongoing work to ensure that all children enjoy the best possible day-to-day learning and play experiences in all spaces at Rolph Road. Teachers regularly teach pro-social skills and promote kindness and positive choices. Helping children develop age-appropriate play and social skills is key to maintaining a caring, welcoming school community where students will experience a sense of joy and belonging. We thank you for reinforcing the importance of kindness and the skills needed for being a good friend.

We recently welcomed Peter Lebuis, TDSB Child and Youth Counsellor at Rolph Road for two sessions with each of our Junior Grade 4-6 classes. Peter provided engaging lessons that included learning about the science behind why kindness is so contagious. Students took a kindness quiz and discussed how kindness impacts communities. Students also learned about the positives associated with conflict as they relate to group dynamics, and the skills needed for resolving conflicts. Classes watched a video and learned about the dangers of othering. We will continue to encourage all students to be *upstanders* by interrupting harmful behaviour.
