CAA SAFTEY PATROLLERS ARE STARTING AT ROUGE VALLEY

Now that spring has arrived, we are excited to announce that our Safety Patroller program will starting soon! Our student patrollers have received training through CAA on how to assist students as they arrive at school each morning. Our patrollers will be positioned at the entry and exit to the bus loop driveway in such a way as to make sure that students who are walking along the sidewalk can do so safely. They will also be responsible for ensuring that only TDSB staff vehicles enter the school parking lot.



Please review the information below regarding the places that parents are able to use for the purpose of drop off and pick up. As always, and especially since the spring weather is here, we encourage all students to walk to school for all of the health and environmental benefits it brings! We are requesting that you follow the directions of our student safety patrollers and remind your child(ren) to follow their directions as well. They will be easy to spot wearing their yellow safety vest. Thank you for helping us to make our school safer for each and every student and supporting our student leadership initiatives!

IMPORTANT REMINDERS to keep all students and staff safe:

- Daily health screening to be completed for each student at home, before entry into the school
- PLEASE, please do not send students to school who are sick or display any symptoms of COVID, flu, or cold, (e.g., headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)
- Rouge Valley will continue to be a MASK FRIENDLY environment
- + Please remind your child(ren) of the importance of good hand hygiene. Practice at home!
