LUNCHTIME REMINDERS

At Rouge Valley, we are committed to fostering a healthy, safe, and inclusive learning environment for all of our students. As part of this commitment, we'd like to take a moment to remind families about our lunch procedures and clarify a few important points.

Fast Food Drop-Offs/Deliveries: While we understand that busy schedules may occasionally call for flexibility, we ask that families do not drop off or arrange for fast food to be delivered to students during the school day. This includes delivery services such as UberEats, DoorDash, and Grubhub. Please note that we do not accept any outside food deliveries for students under any circumstances. This policy is in place for several important reasons:

- Health and Nutrition: We strive to support and promote lifelong healthy eating habits among our students.
- Minimizing Disruptions: Food deliveries and drop-offs interrupt front office operations and classroom routines, impacting the learning environment.



lunch recess, our Lunchroom Supervisors are on yard duty and cannot supervise students who are still waiting for, or eating a late lunch. **Equity and Inclusion**: Not all students have access to special outside meals, which may lead to feelings of exclusion or distraction among peers. Students who bring fast food will be required to eat it on the benches outside the office, which also presents a supervision concern. If you would like to treat your child to a special meal, we encourage you to sign them out for lunch and enjoy it together. This option is the least disruptive to our daily routines and supports our lunch procedures. And don't forget, we continue to offer Subway lunches on Tuesdays and Pizza lunches on Thursdays. Orders can be placed through SchoolCash Online. By ordering, your child will receive a special meal, AND you are supporting our school's fundraising efforts!

Forgotten Lunches

Please rest assured that **no student will ever go hungry at Rouge Valley**. Our school snack program ensures that any student who forgets their lunch will be provided with something to eat. If you are bringing in a forgotten lunch, please do so by 11:30 a.m. so that your child can eat it in his/her classroom, while supervised by our Lunchroom Supervisors. We appreciate your continued support and cooperation in helping us make Rouge Valley a welcoming and supportive space for all students!

IMPORTANT REMINDERS to keep all students and staff safe:

- Daily health screening to be completed for each student at home, before entry into the school
- PLEASE, <u>please do not send students to school who are sick or display any symptoms of COVID, flu, or cold, (e.g., headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)</u>



- + Please remind your child(ren) of the importance of good hand hygiene. Practice at home!
- STUDENTS need to be ON TIME to enter the school at the bell

The bus loop is a designated fire route. You MAY drop off your child(ren) along the bus loop but PLEASE DO NOT park in the bus loop— keep the traffic moving!



Whenever possible, and to decrease the congestion in front of our school, we encourage all of our students to WALK TO SCHOOL. It is a great way for children to receive daily exercise, reduces pollution and other environmental impacts, and most of all, promotes a healthy, active lifestyle!
