What is Progressive Discipline?

The TDSB follows a progressive discipline approach to promote a safe, inclusive and accepting school climate. Progressive discipline is a whole-school approach that utilizes a continuum of interventions, supports, and consequences to address inappropriate student behaviour and to build on strategies that promote positive behaviours. Consequences are developmentally and social-emotionally appropriate and take into consideration mitigating circumstances. When inappropriate behaviour occurs, disciplinary measures are applied within a framework that shifts the focus from one that is solely punitive to one that is corrective, supportive and restorative. At Rouge Valley, we strive to utilize a range of interventions, supports, and consequences that include learning opportunities for reinforcing positive behaviour, while helping students to make positive choices.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS to keep all students and staff safe:

- Daily health screening to be completed for each student at home, before entry into the school
- PLEASE, please do not send students to school who are sick or display any symptoms of COVID, flu, or cold, (e.g., headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)



- Rouge Valley will continue to be a MASK FRIENDLY environment
- Please remind your child(ren) of the importance of good hand hygiene. Practice at home!
- STUDENTS need to be ON TIME to enter the school at the bell
