We had a practice fire drill this past week and the students and staff did great! :)

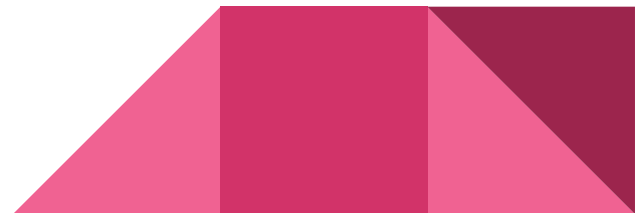
We want to thank everyone for knowing what to do in an emergency and getting out of the building as quickly and quietly as possible.

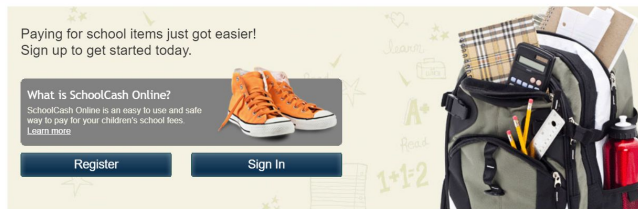

# School Improvement Planning @ Roywood PS

We are focusing on including more student voice into classroom programming and throughout the school. Some of the ways that we are doing this is through:

- Offering student choice in presentation formats
- Virtual announcements each day with students included

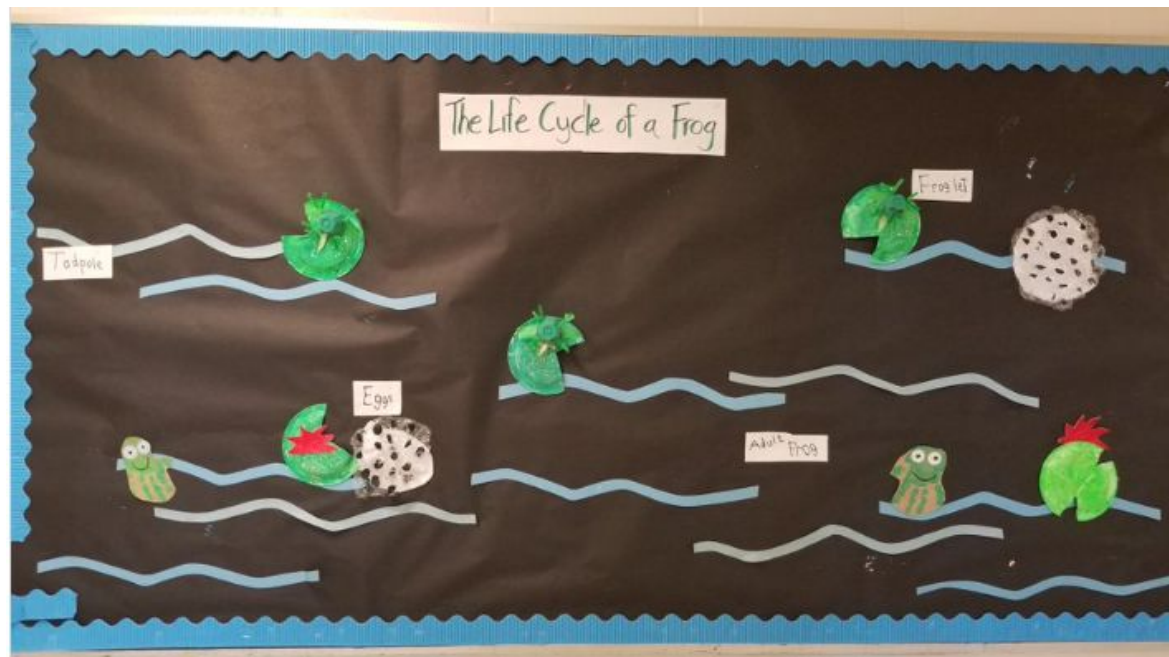




Love the spring scenes that can be seen in the hallway. How many:

5. What else do you notice?






The life cycle of a frog can be seen in the hallway!

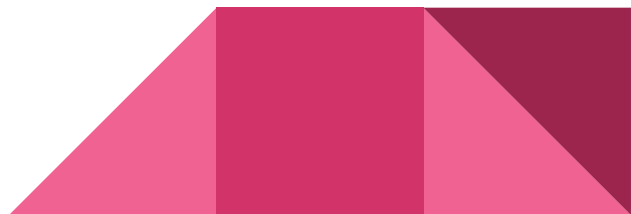
