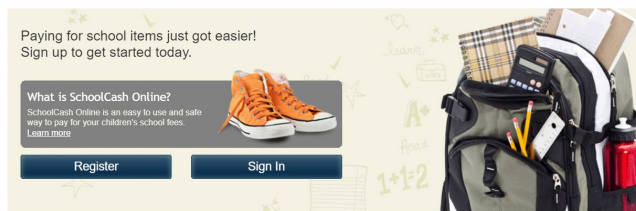

- And more...

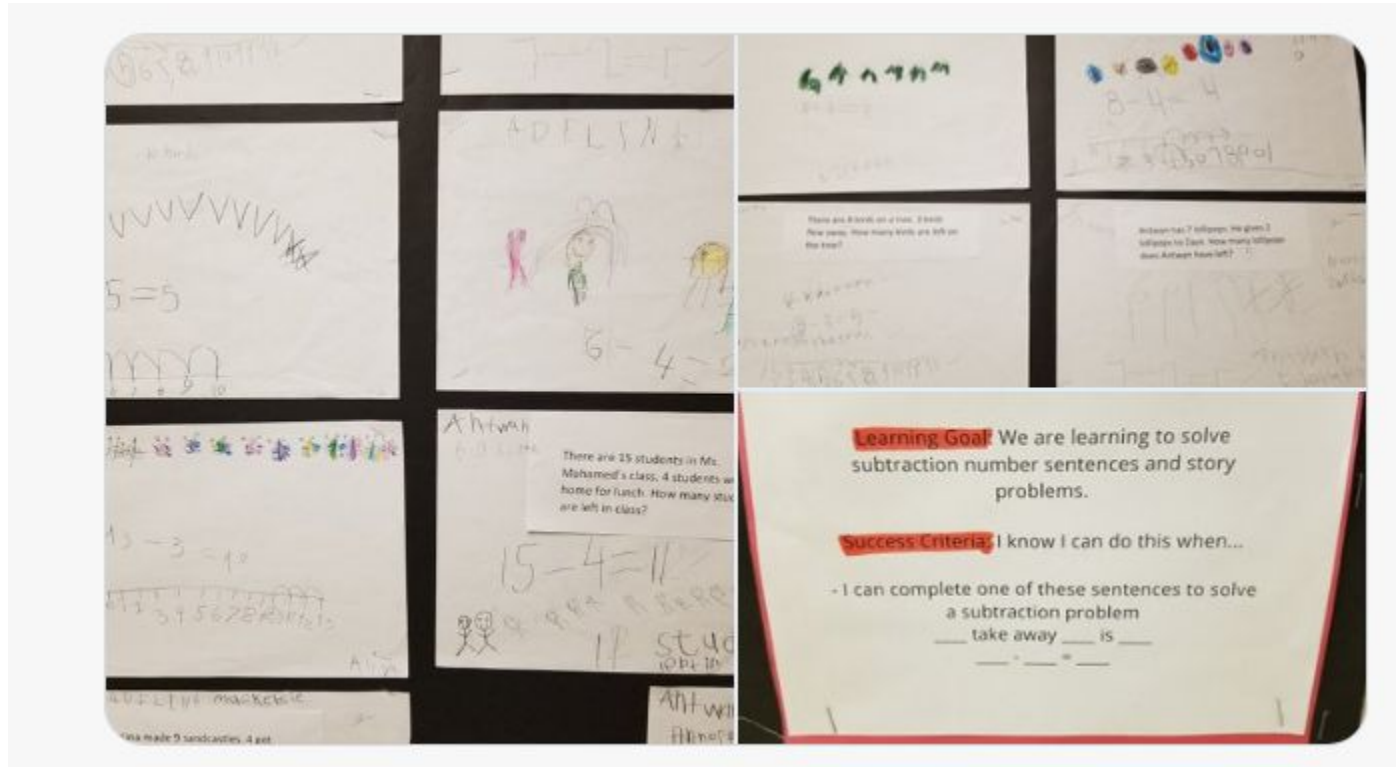


This Week @ Roywood PS
