

New Communication Options for Families - School Messenger

The following information was shared with all TDSB families last week:

The TDSB is offering two new ways for parents and caregivers to stay connected with their school and the TDSB.

- 1. Parents and caregivers will have an opportunity to opt in to receive text messages from their school and TDSB in addition to receiving messages through email. A text message will be sent to you to the phone number you have on file in September inviting you to opt in.
- 2. Families will also have the option to use the <u>School Messenger</u> app or website for a faster and easier way to report absences and receive communication sent by the TDSB and your school.
