



POST SECONDARY PATHWAYS


Degree or partial degree followed by College diploma.






APPRENTICESHIPS

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TEACHING STRATEGIES Learn on the job.

PROGRAM LENGTH

3-5 years; Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program allows students to begin in high school.

TUITION

Earn while you learn.

COLLEGE DESIGNATIONS

Colleges grant 1,2, 3 year diplomas.

Most colleges grant 4 year **bachelor degrees**.

Some colleges have **joint programs** with universities; 2 years at college followed by 2 years at university.

Some colleges have **articulated agreements** with universities; 3 years at college followed by **advanced standing** at university to earn both a diploma and a degree.


6 Grade 12 U/M Courses

Some universities require ENG4U to be included in the top 6 courses.

Universities consider Grade 12 final marks for admission. Universities may make early conditional offers based on Grade 11 final marks.

LIFE/HEALTH SCIENCES

PROGRAMS

Kinesiology, nursing, health science, etc.

DEGREE

Bachelor of Science (BSc.)

ENG4U (mandatory) MHF4U (Advanced Functions), MCV4U (Calculus), or MDM4U (Data Management) 3 additional U/M Grade 12 courses.

*Business courses are not required.







Grade 11 marks are always transmitted to OUAC, but it is your Grade 12 marks that determine Dear Anthony, Universities make conditional offers in a number of rounds between January and the end of May. your admission. If a university does not have final marks for your Grade 12 prerequisites at the time of an "offer cycle", they will look at your Grade 11 marks to see whether they can give you an early If your Grade 11 marks are not the strongest, conditional offer. your conditional offer will come out in a future "offer cycle" when the universities have access to Grade 12 final marks. 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Only if you are applying to the Math, Accounting and Engineering Programs at the University of Dear Praveen, Waterloo will you be asked to explain why you have taken a course outside your regular day school (i.e. private school). U of Waterloo may adjust (lower) your overall admission score if they believe your private school credit is a shortcut to a higher mark. Other universities caution students against taking any outside courses for the sole purpose of a high mark. It might seem like a shortcut to get into a university program, but it won't keep you in the program. For that you need to put in the hard work!
