

Secondary School Credit Summer Programs 2021 Information Sheet

The Toronto District School Board is offering, through the Continuing Education and e-Learning Departments, the following summer programming to current secondary school students:

1. Remote Credit Recovery: For TDSB Students ONLY

The Toronto District School Board is offering current TDSB students the opportunity to recover one or two credits for the month of July 2021. Remote Summer Credit Recovery courses are open to current TDSB high school students who have taken the course in the past two years but have not earned the credit. All classes are remote, there are no in-person classes available. Regular attendance in the remote environment is a requirement.

Students may enroll in one course either in the AM or PM, or in two courses, one in the AM and one in the PM.

While credit recovery may provide an expedient option to achieve an unsuccessful credit, it may not be the best option in terms of preparing students for further studies in that discipline. Students should speak with their guidance counsellor to determine whether a better option might be to enrol in the full credit course option – either through Remote Summer Full Credit or Hybrid programming.

2. Remote Summer Full Credit Program:

Students can enroll in one full-credit course that is offered in July only. **All classes are remote** in the remote learning model. In our Remote Learning model students will be at home learning live with their teacher daily from 9:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. and again from 2:00 p.m.- 3:15 p.m. Students will be able to receive extra help daily from 1:30 p.m.- 2:00 p.m. **Note:** Civics and Career Studies are half credit courses that equals one full credit course, and as such, are taken together in one month.

3. Hybrid Summer Full Credit Program:

Students can enroll in one full-credit course that is offered in July only. Classes will take place at selected school sites. Should an announcement be made that only remote learning can take place students need to be prepared to pivot to remote learning. In our Hybrid Learning model students will be following a three(3) day rotating schedule including in person, synchronous and asynchronous learning. **Note:** Civics and Career Studies are half credit courses that equals one full credit course, and as such, are taken together in one month.

4. E-Learning Full Credit Summer Program

There are two e-Learning summer sessions offering full credit courses - one in the month of July and one in August. A variety of grade 11 and 12 courses are offered as well as the two grade 10 half credit courses, civics and career studies. Students may only enrol in one e-learning course per session for a maximum of two courses. With e-Learning, the curriculum is delivered entirely online and allows for flexibility in a student's schedule. However, students are expected to log into Brightspace everyday and should plan to commit about six hours daily to their course. **Note:** Civics and Career Studies are half credit courses that equals one full credit course, and as such, are taken together in one month.
