#### **FUNDRAISING**

## **Big Box of Cards**

\$33 for 33 birthday cards

One sample box per family, as well as promo materials provided

Target is to start the last week of Sept/first week of Oct

If a family doesn't want it, the sample can come back, but often they purchase it.

The payment method is still to be determined

#### **World Famous Chocolate**

There was a discussion on nut-free vs nut options (chocolate almonds) and all agreed to pursue the latter as it's more successful and simple with boxes being \$3/piece. Families with children with nut allergies can choose to sell the nut-free options. Michael has confirmed all families last year with children with nut allergies are comfortable with this fundraiser and he'll contact any new families this year.

Each family can take a case home (case has 30 boxes of chocolate almonds).

Even having 250 families, sell one case each will lead to sales of \$10,000.

Money can also be allocated for prizes and Tracy the lead will look into how to present, i.e. going into classes rather than a school assembly.

It's ideal to run over 3 weekends, timing TBD but likely over Thanksgiving to target family/friends.
